

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
for Educational and Scientific Cooperation
between
Kyoto University acting through
The Faculty of Engineering and Graduate School of Engineering
and
The University of Hong Kong acting through
The Faculty of Engineering

The Faculty of Engineering and Graduate School of Engineering of Kyoto University and The Faculty of Engineering of The University of Hong Kong (hereinafter referred to as "the Parties" and separately, as "Party") join in the following Memorandum of Understanding in order to promote mutual cooperation on education and scientific research in the engineering discipline.


1. The Parties will promote in particular the following activities:
[1] Exchange of scientific materials, publications, and information;
[2] Exchange of faculty members and researchers; and
[3] Joint research and meetings for research with Emerging Technologies Institute, The University of Hong Kong.
2. These activities are to be carried out after mutual consultation and subject to mutual agreement of the Parties.
3. All financial arrangements to pursue any of the above activities are to be negotiated for each specific case and subject to mutual agreement of the Parties.
4. The Parties agree that, in the event of research collaboration leading to patent rights, copyrights, or other intellectual property rights, a further agreement shall be negotiated in each case in accordance with the policies of the Parties on intellectual property.
5. This Memorandum of Understanding shall be effective upon signature by the Parties and shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years and it may be further extended by mutual agreement of the Parties .
6. This Memorandum of Understanding may be terminated by one (1) month prior written notice of either Party. If such notice is given, the Parties agree to ensure that all commitments to projects, in progress at the date of termination, shall be honored until the completion of the projects.
7. Any amendment to this Memorandum of Understanding will require the written approval of both Parties. Such amendments shall become effective immediately upon said approval by both Parties.
8. This Memorandum of Understanding is written and executed in English.
9. This Memorandum of Understanding will not be legally binding upon the Parties and contains only the understanding upon which the Parties may proceed to negotiate the details of each activity.
