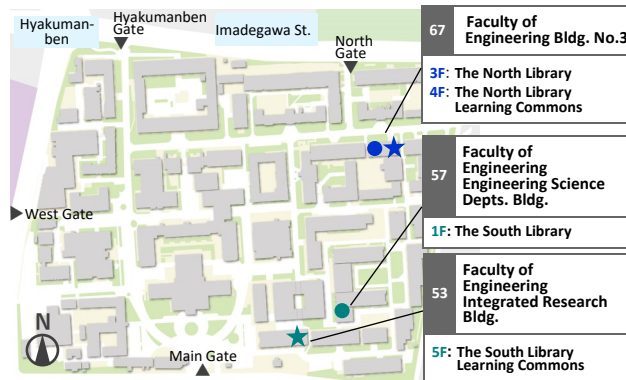

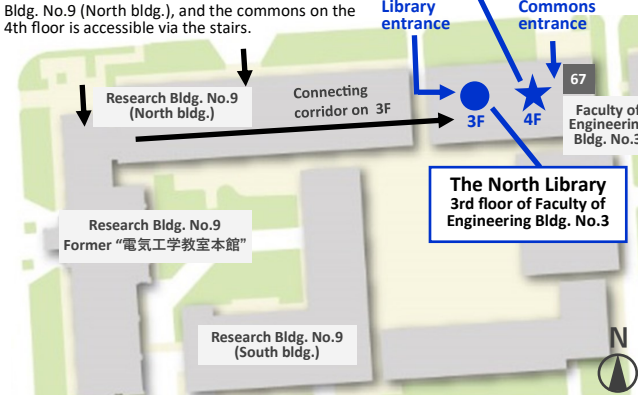

Access



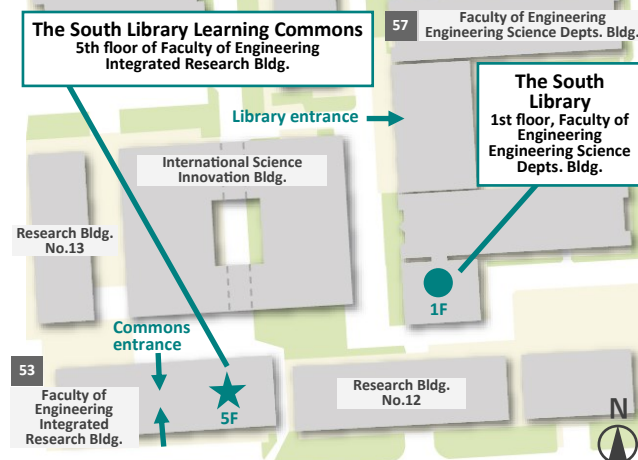
The North Library/Commons entrance

5th floor of Faculty of Engineering Integrated Research Bldg.

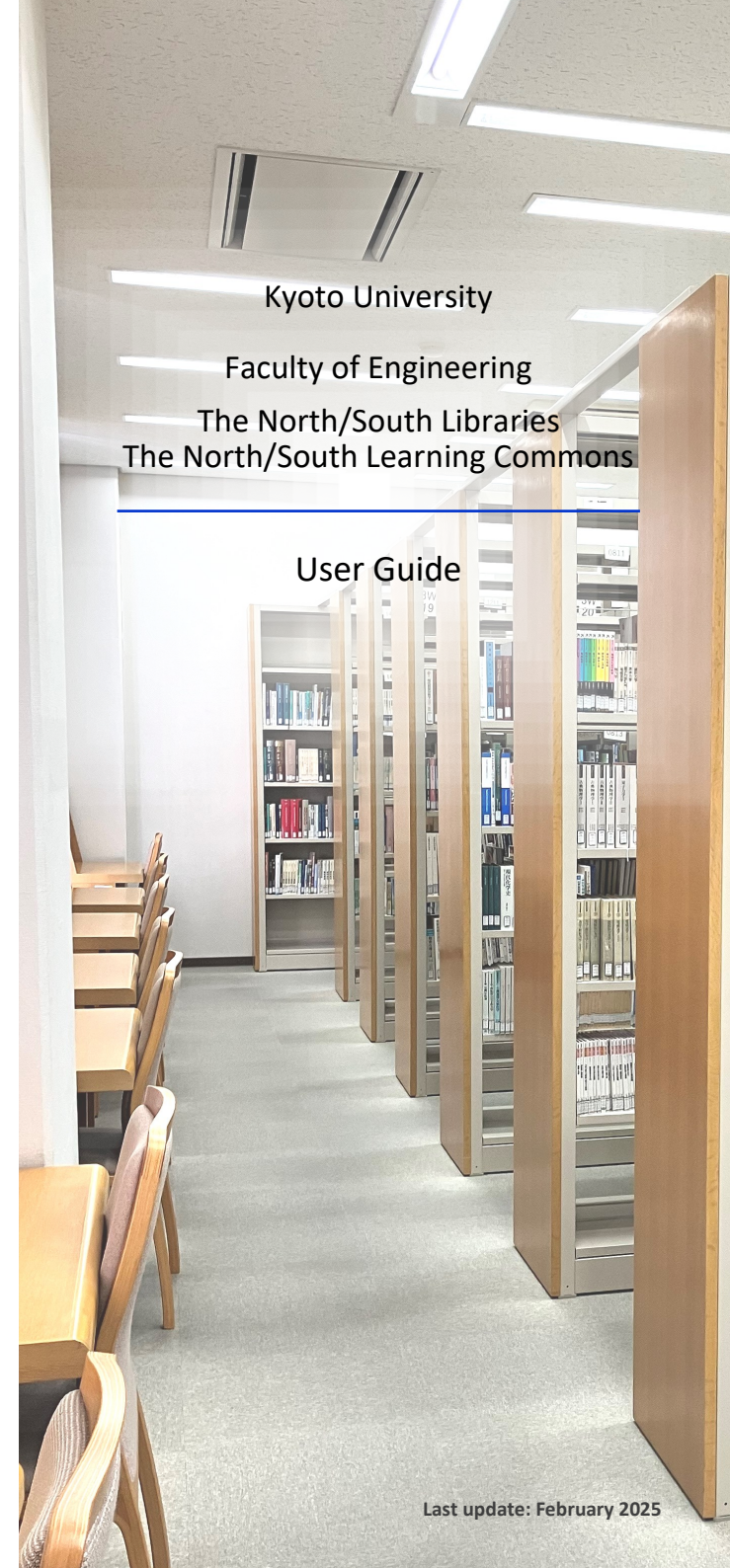

- * When the library is closed, please return the books to the book drop near the entrance.
- * You can renew your loan period using online service "MyKULINE".
- * You can renew up to 5 times for open-shelf books and up to 2 times for stack-room books.
- * Student ID card/authentication IC card/library card is required to enter the library and borrow/renew books.

How to Search/Request/Use Materials

- * Books, journals, e-journals and e-books can be searched through "KULINE" (KU Libraries Online Catalog).

You can also reserve materials that are currently on loan or place holds on materials through KULINE.

- * You can request books or photocopies from other campuses.

If Kyoto University does not hold the materials you are looking for, you can request them from other institutions. (charged service)

※If you pay with private expense, the Main Library will handle your requests.

- * To use e-journals, e-books and databases, you need to set up an authentication system.

You can use e-resources not only on campus but also from off-campus environment such as home with the authentication system.
