
The North/South Library Learning Commons


The Learning commons is a space for various learning activities such as self-study and group work. The room is equipped with white board and power supplies and can be used for multiple purposes.

* Books, journals, e-journals and e-books can be searched through "KULINE" (KU Libraries Online Catalog).



You can also reserve materials that are currently on loan or place holds on materials through KULINE.


* You can request books or photocopies from other campuses.
