## ACCESS


### The North Library/ Commons entrance

5th floor of Faculty of Engineering Integrated Research Bldg.



### About Learning Commons

---

The North/South Library Learning Commons opened in May 2022. The Learning Commons is a space for various learning activities such as self-study and group work.

The rooms are equipped with whiteboards and outlets, and can be used for multiple purposes.

### Users

---

- Kyoto University students, faculty and staff
- These spaces are not available to non-KU users (including alumni).

### Opening Hours

---

Weekdays 9:00 AM – 5:00 PM

- The opening days and hours are the same as those of the North/South Library.

### Drink Policy

---

- All drinks must be in spill-resistant beverage containers. (e.g., water bottles, aluminum cans with screw lids, plastic bottles, etc.)
- Paper cups without lids and pull-tab cans are not allowed.
- No food is allowed.

### Notes on COVID-19

---

- Please sanitize your hands with alcohol sanitizer at the entrance before use.
- Sanitizing products are available. Please wipe your desk before use.
